









Construction on Lainhart Dam

- Construction at the Lainhart Dam is expected to start in the first week of July
- The public will not be able to use the dam during this period
- A temporary portage will be added on the east side of the Lainhart Dam for public access

Project Background



USGS Monitoring Station at Lainhart Dam

Lainhart Dam functions as a stage and flow monitoring location for the Minimum Flows and Level Rule (2003)

Changes in the stage-discharge relationships can cause errors in reported flows

- Natural occurring banks are subject to erosion
- Piping of material and seepage loss has occurred through both dams
- The sheet piling system has degraded and allows flow around the dams
