Summary Statement: This position performs semi-skilled and unskilled construction, installation, maintenance and / or general repair work to support the operations of the District's wastewater collection system as required. This position works within a general outline of work to be performed and utilizing standard work methods and sequences under general supervision.

Key Responsibilities: The Collection & Distribution System Operator Trainee is responsible for:

- Receives training and assists in general maintenance and cleaning duties related to the District's
 wastewater collection system; clean sewers mains and laterals, operates a high pressure rodder;
 manual power rodder; vacuums debris from lift stations and related structures.
- Performs minor maintenance such as painting, float cleaning, and mowing.
- Performs work in confined spaces; takes appropriate precautions prior to entering confined spaces with use of air quality monitors and ventilators per supervision instruction and SOP.
- Trains on preventative and corrective maintenance on District lift stations equipment including pumps, generators, electrical panels.
- Trains on how to Trouble shoot minor lift station electrical problems when possible.
- Assists other District personnel on related projects.
- Maintains accurate logs of repairs/ maintenance done.
- Operate a variety of vehicles, equipment, and tools including; service trucks, vacuum trucks, trailers, hand and power tools.
- Inspects and maintains assigned equipment and vehicles; performs safety checks and checks fluid levels of vehicles and equipment.
- Provides courteous customer service.
- Serves in emergency standby capacity.
